

#### **COVID IN BRAZIL**

While we may be starting to feel more optimistic about the course of the pandemic in this country, the situation is very different in Brazil. Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) is giving a vital life-line to some of the poorest families in Brazil's Amazonia State hit hardest by the COVID-19 pandemic. They are supporting an initiative by Capuchin Friars Minor, providing food baskets for 100 poverty-stricken families every month. Friar Paolo Maria Braghini told ACN that the project, which runs from February to August, is vital given the grinding poverty in Manaus – the capital of Amazonas State, where infection rates soared by 42.3 percent in the last week of April.
