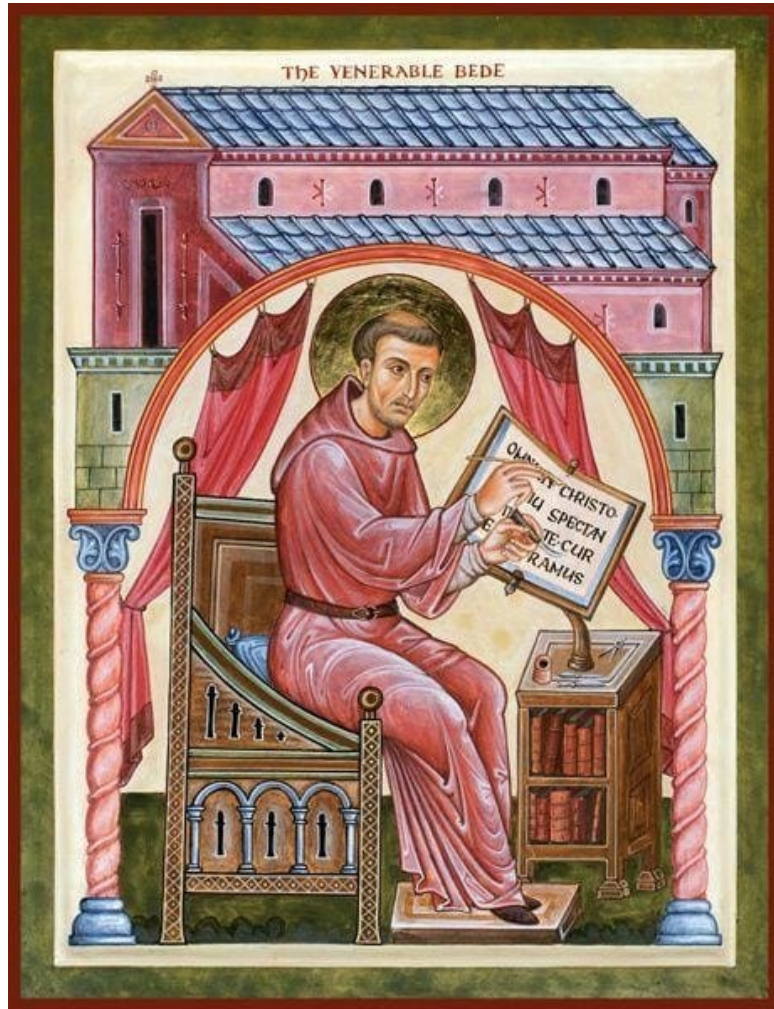

ACN – AID TO THE CHURCH IN NEED

Syrian Christian families who found a safe haven in the port city of Lattakia, after fleeing from Idlib and other north-eastern cities held by jihadist rebels, suffered again when earthquakes struck in February. Hundreds of them saw their homes damaged or destroyed. ACN is providing help to those suffering after these earthquakes caused such massive destruction in Turkey and Syria. NATIONAL GALLERY – SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI

Come face-to-face with one of history's most inspirational and revered figures in the first major UK art exhibition to explore Saint Francis of Assisi's life and legacy. Presenting the art and imagery of Saint Francis (1182–1226) from the 13th century to today, this exhibition looks at why this saint is a figure of enormous relevance to our time due to his spiritual radicalism, commitment to the poor, and love of God and nature, as well as his powerful appeals for peace, and openness to dialogue with other religions. The exhibition will continue until 30 July, in the Ground Floor Galleries of the National Gallery in Trafalgar Square, WC2N 5DN. Free entrance, but please book a free Gallery entry ticket.
