THOMAS “TOM” BEAUMONT RIP

The Requiem Mass for Thomas (Tom) Beaumont who died aged 74 years, will take place here on Friday 16 June at 11.00 am. Tom had lived in Chelsea all his life and was a long-time parishioner, from his earliest years as an altar boy. As a result of Parkinson’s Disease, he was admitted into the Chiswick Nursing Centre at the beginning of January 2021. After his long battle with Parkinson’s, he died in Charing Cross Hospital on 24 May with his family and friends at his bedside. May he Rest in Peace.
