GLASS DOOR

Glass Door is a local charity, working with homeless people. This year there has been a 37% increase in referrals for night shelters. Nearly half of Glass Door's guests are aged between 18 and 35, signalling a rise in homelessness among young people. The night shelters close during the summer, but Glass Door's work helping people to find a route out of homelessness goes on. The support church congregations give Glass Door is vital for their work, so please give the homeless people around us an Easter gift by donating to Glass Door. WHAT SHOULD I DO?

We recently received the following advice from Glass Door: "we are often asked 'what can I helpfully do if I see someone sleeping rough?' Aside from saying hello and having a chat, offering to buy a warm drink or giving spare change, one thing you could do is make a Streetlink referral", see thestreetlink.org.uk. It can be a surprise to find out how a simple mistake or a minor illness can result is a person being made homeless. The homeless are often people with backgrounds similar to our own. It may just be that they are too embarrassed to admit it.
