ASH WEDNESDAY

"And pray to God to have mercy upon us
And pray that I may forget
These matters that with myself I too much discuss
Too much explain
Because I do not hope to turn again
Let these words answer
For what is done, not to be done again
May the judgement not be too heavy upon us."

In this verse from his poem "Ash Wednesday", T.S. Eliot is touching on Lenten themes of seeking God's mercy, repentance (turning away from sin) and our reluctance to change. Even if we cannot admit what we have done wrong, we can at least begin by admitting that we have done wrong. This is significance of our being blessed with ashes on Ash Wednesday. It is the first step in our Lenten journey.
