

**Monday 28<sup>th</sup> St Lawrence Ruiz and Companions** – Martyred in Japan during the persecution of Christians in the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

Tuesday 29th St Michael, St Gabriel and St Raphael - Archangels

**Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> St Jerome** – A biblical scholar, often depicted with a lion on account of the legend that he removed a thorn from a lion's paw and the now tame lion became his companion, and servant of his monastery.

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October St Thérèse – known as "the Little Flower". Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> The Holy Guardian Angels – often forgotten, always there.
